## About KIIT University

## LDP 2017 : Digital Preservation and Utilization of Intellectual Resources

Digital preservation has recently been regarded as the most key requirement for all digital libraries across the world to preserve precious electronic documents systematically for perpetual access in a convenient way as there has been a prolific growth of e-documents of late leading to a chaotic situation of accessing right literature conveniently in right time. In this context, DSpace is found to be a boon in setting of institutional repositories in respective institutions.

Moreover, DSpace is one of the most popular software, jointly developed and promoted by MIT & HP which is used to manage collection of information, with associated services, where the information is stored in digital formats and accessible over a network.

LIS Professionals have been putting sincere efforts in exploring potentials of this model in Library Digitization. With the objective to give practical hands on training on DSpace this workshop is specially designed for library professionals, LIS Academicians, Information Managers and LIS students. It provides practical training to the participants to build digital library/institutional repository collection at their respective libraries and information centres. Interestingly, KIIT University is the first in Eastern India to host such an emerging workshop that intends to impart hands on training on Windows based latest version of DSpace with necessary guidelines for its feasible implementation.

### LDP Objectives

- Familiarize participants with the concepts of FLOSS based Library Digitization.
- Facilitate to acquire hands-on technical expertise to implement and manage DSpace(Window).
- Offer hands on experience to explore and manage core modules of DSpace(Window) along with value-added and additional features and utilities of the software.
- Help participants to develop necessary skills in installation, server and client configuration, system parameter setting and DMA (Digital Media Archive)
