

## SDG 4 QUALITY EDUCATION



### 1 Introduction:

The University's aim to provide access to quality education to the masses irrespective of the caste, creed, religion and gender is aligned with the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4 of the United Nations. In a country like India, with diversity in culture, tradition, religious beliefs, reaching out to one and all for quality education at affordable cost is a near indomitable feat. The University works in close association with its sister organization, Kalinga Institute of Social Sciences, its

internal societies and the Government in this direction to make the feat a reality.

This report is organized as follows. Section 1 provides the introduction to the report. Section 2 mentions the goals of the University in attaining and contributing to SDG4. Section 3 outlines the different initiatives taken by the University in this respect during the year 2018-19. Section 4 provides the impact of these initiatives.

### 2 Goals

The goals are defined as:

- Imparting value based quality education of international standard and imbining skill for solving real life problems.
- Inculcating global perspective in attitude.
- Instilling habit of continual learning.
- To empower 2 million indigenous children through quality education.

### **3 Initiatives:**

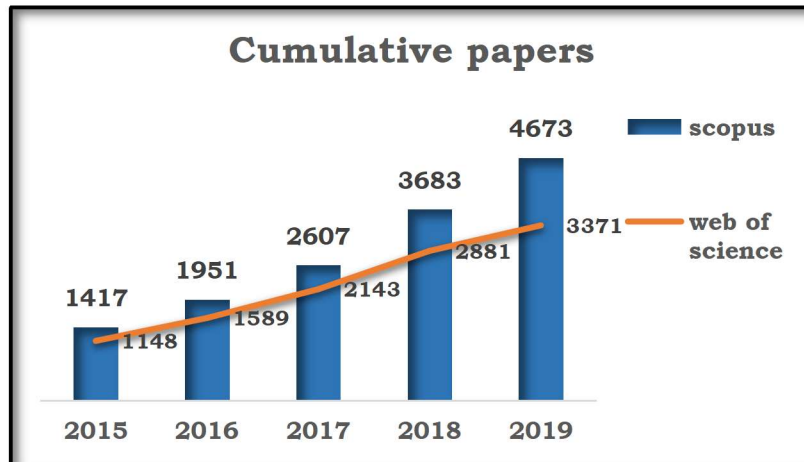
The University is continually involved in educational outreach activities beyond the campus through its faculty members, staff and also its students. They provide voluntary and free educational programs to School students in remote and rural areas belonging to different standards. Simple scientific experiments and demonstrations are carried out to inspire the students belonging to poor communities to continue their education with a goal to excel in life. The University has adopted several Schools where it provides financial support, development of academic infrastructure, libraries, proper sanitation and recreation facilities to the students of the area. Faculty members are engaged in providing training to the teachers on content delivery, public speaking and students/parent counseling to reduce dropout rates. Voluntary teaching classes with students with special learning activities are carried out in different schools once or twice a month by both the faculty members and senior students of the University. Awareness camps on education, health and hygiene are

carried out every month in selected areas. Special vocational and skill development programs are also carried out with high school students belonging to poor communities to ensure that they have a stable livelihood. A community engagement cell has been set up in this regard. All these programs are carried out both on adhoc and programmed basis. Besides, the staff and students enormously contribute to the educational ventures of its sister concern, Kalinga Institute of Social Sciences (KISS) which started in Bhubaneswar and is now on its way to setting up satellite centers to reach out more to the downtrodden segments of the society with the mission to eradicate poverty by providing quality education to all.

### **Academic Research**

Academic Research focuses on current research topics that uses formal, scientific and systematic procedures to discover answers.

Papers indexed in scopus and web of science over the years is given below:



Research on academic topics around SDGs are also being given importance in the University. Research on Quality education leading to quality papers is being carried out. The list of papers on quality education published in 2018 and 2019 are given in **Appendix I**.

- Placement opportunity for University Students  
The University has been getting cent percent placement since inception. More than 6000 students get placed each year. With more than

500 students getting multiple offers. The highest package for the year 2019 was 33.00 lakhs while the average was 6.00 lakhs

- Placement opportunity for tribal Students  
5000 alumni of KISS are already placed in different government, non government, banking as well as corporate sectors with an average salary package of 4.00 lakhs. KIIT has helped the first generation learners to come out from their unrecognised lives inside the jungle to social mainstream and helped to lead a decent life.
- Placement opportunity for Unemployed Youth  
The University conducts skill development programmes for school dropouts and unemployed youth to motivate them to learn a customally designed skill as per their interest and pursue their career in that line. Not only the students are skilled as per field, counselor are there to counsel the students to take up the job available in different sectors to earn their livelihood. In 18-19, KIIT has

trained 30000+ youth of Odisha through various skill development programmes and placed them in the large companies, NGO and financial sector.

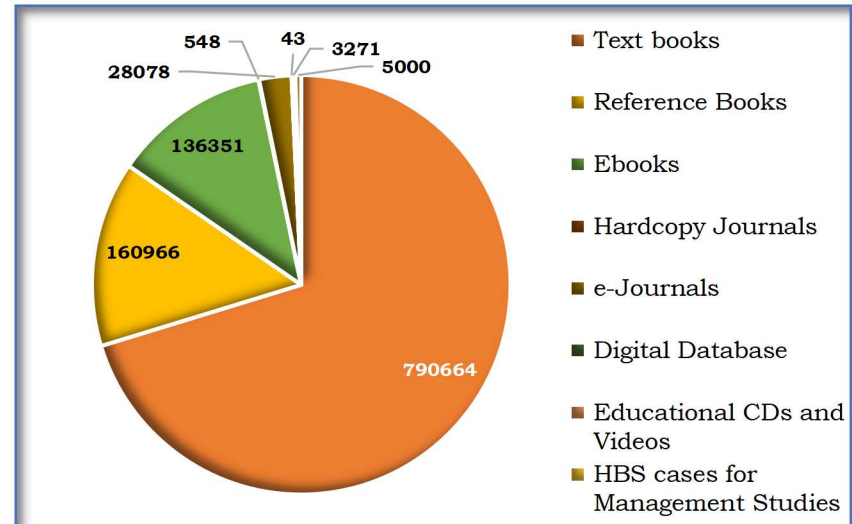
Highlights to all these activities are given in the following sections:

### 3.1 Access to Library for General Public

Resources available in the library

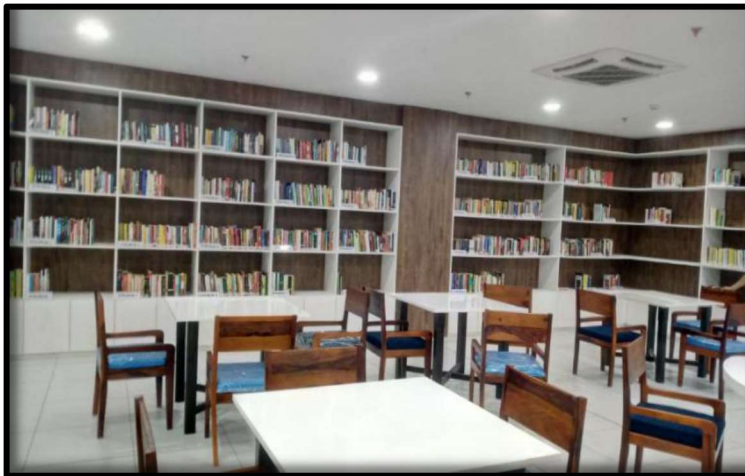

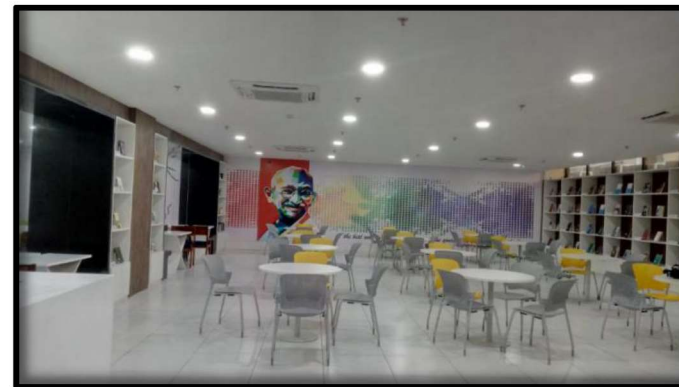

**Kavyaa, Library on poetic genres**



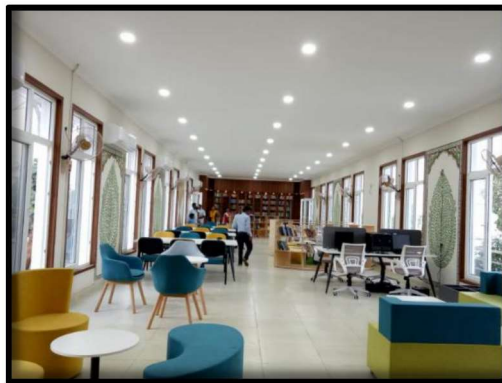

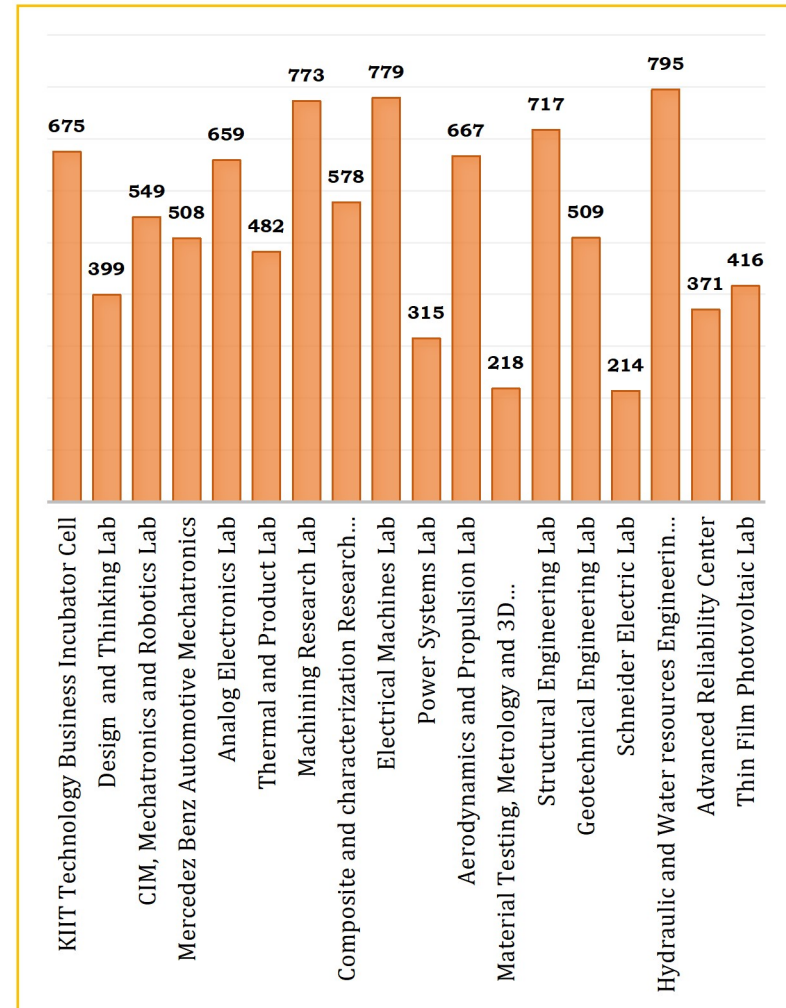

### 3.4 Kalinga Institute of Social Sciences (KISS)

Kalinga Institute of Social Sciences – KISS, Bhubaneswar, India is a fully free, fully residential home for 30000 poor indigenous/tribal children who are provided holistic education from kindergarten to post graduation along with lodging, boarding, health care facilities besides vocational, life skills empowerment. The University plans to educate 2,00,000 indigenous (tribal) children over the next decade and in the process of setting up branches in 10 states, with the support of respective state governments, and in all 30 districts of Odisha. Students are high achievers in academics, co-curricular activities and national and international sports, making it a highly successful model of tribal empowerment through education. KISS has so far set up centers in Delhi, Mayurbhanj, Balasore are currently functioning.

KISS Delhi <https://www.kissdelhi.ac.in/> is a joint venture of Govt. of National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi and KISS Bhubaneswar to provide quality education and vocational training to the children belonging to the economically weaker section of the society and orphans is a fully free residential school presently has student strength of 1200 and imparts education from Class I to Class XII under Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) curriculum. The School is fully supported by the Govt. of Delhi and managed by

the Chief Executive Officer, KISS Delhi and his team very successfully.

Recognizing the success of KISS model in Bhubaneswar, Bangladesh is all set to replicate a congruent version of it in Dhaka and Jessore. Branch at Dhaka is being set up in association with Daffodil International University, Dhaka. Jessore Branch is supported by 'Banchte Shekha', a leading NGO led by Dr. Angela Gomes, Ramon Magsaysay Laureate. KISS shall provide technical and managerial support for the functioning of the two branches.

A new branch of KISS is being established in Kolkata, West Bengal, in collaboration with 'Help Us Help Them', a Kolkata based NGO that promotes the same cause. The school shall be a residential school for over 1000 children and will have the same structural model as KISS.

Set up in Baripada in association with Adani Foundation, Ahmadabad (<https://www.adanifoundation.org/>), KISS - Mayurbhanj

provide quality education to the underprivileged tribal children of the tribal dominated district as well as neighboring districts.

Emami KISS Residential School is a joint venture with Emami Group (<http://www.emamilttd.in/>). Modeled along the lines of the original, innovative campus at KISS, it will function as a residential academic centre providing holistic education, accommodation, food, health care, study material and sports training to its students free of cost.

‘Oswal- KISS Residential School’ has been established in Bolangir, Odisha in association with Oswal Group (<http://www.oswalgroup.com/>). The School will provide quality education to the underprivileged tribal children of the district and adjoining areas.

Faculty members and students from Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology, regularly visit KISS branches to contribute in academic activities and educational ventures to its students round the year.

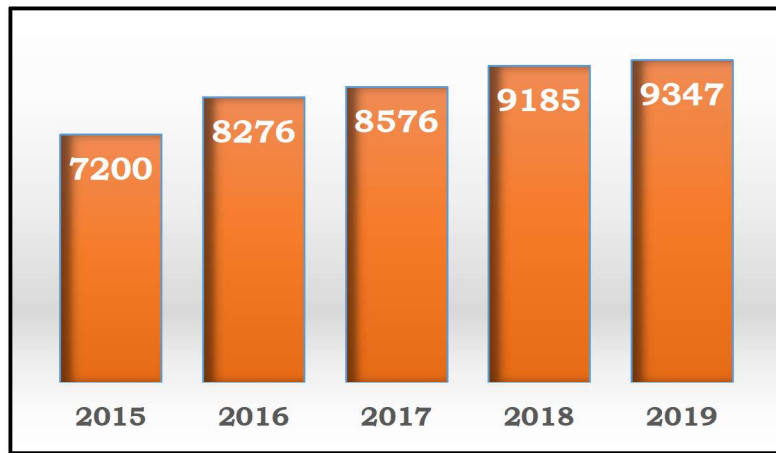

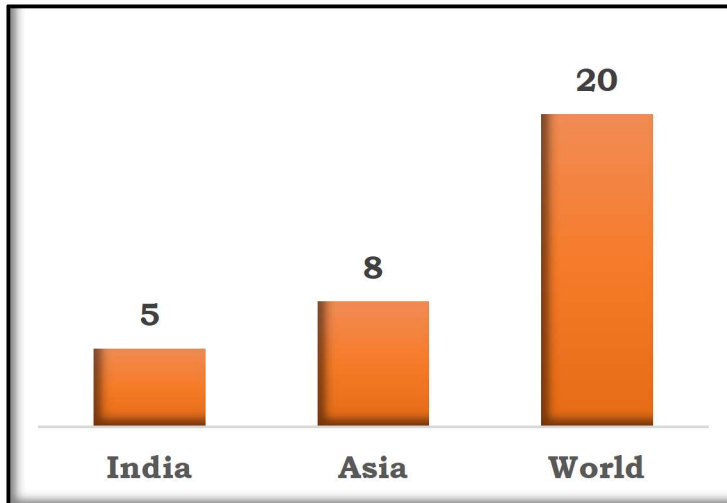

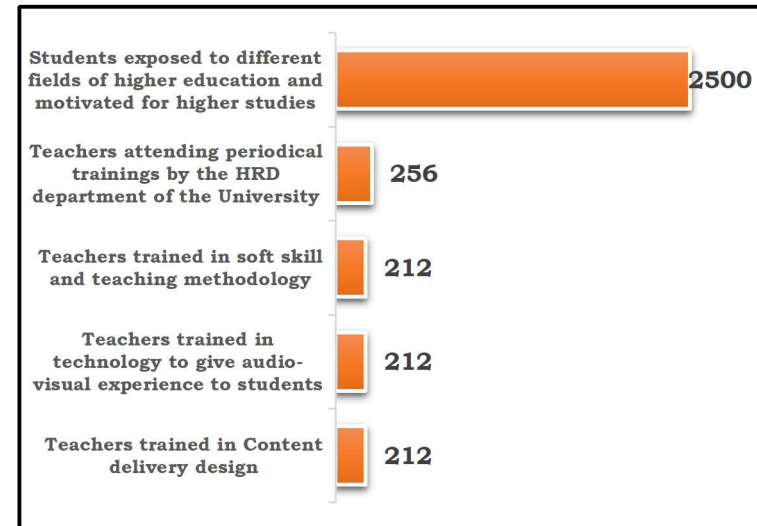

6.Conducting periodical training of the teachers by the HRD department of the University with special focus on academic leadership.



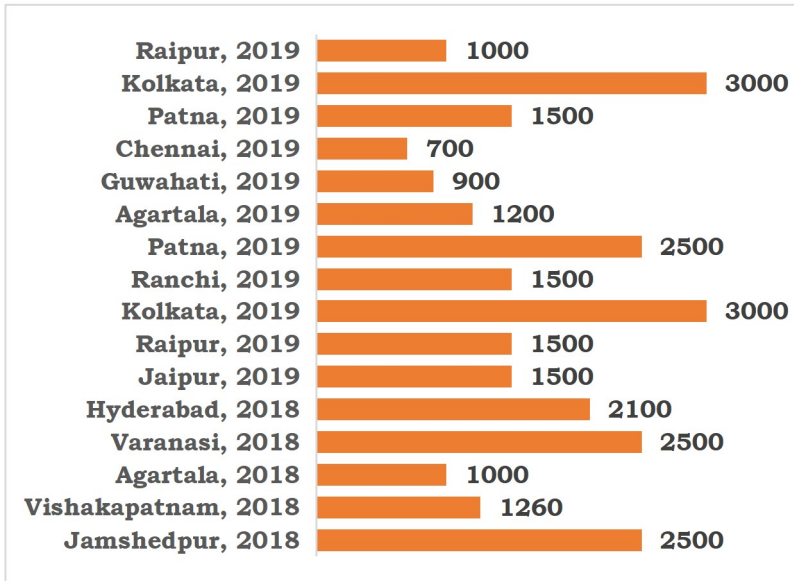

‘Education for All’ Marathon organized at 36 venues across state of Odisha saw participation by 75000 people from all walks of life.



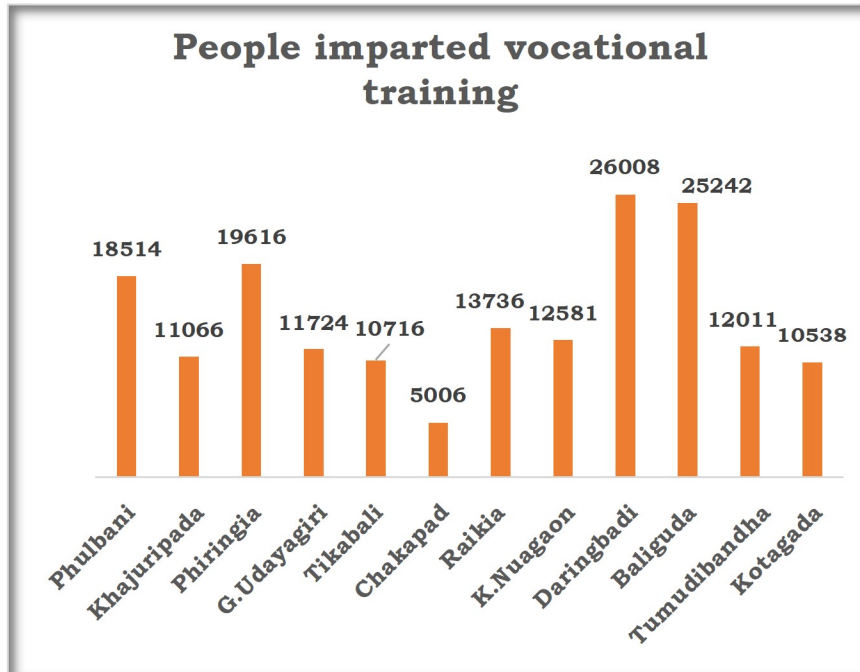

**3.10 Adoption of Panchayats and Villages**

10 panchayats in Kandhamal and Mayurbhanj have been adopted and work has already been started in 2 districts to impart skill development training to the youth to make the area an unemployment free zone.

The University has conducted several SC-ST program in various technology-based programs supported by National Science & Technology Entrepreneurship Development Board, Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India for rural community. The programs not only bring awareness but have also

ensued in promoting a few rural persons for developing technology-based enterprises.

The University has adopted 10 local villages to develop as model villages, where students are being taught by the University faculty from time to time. List of villages adopted are: Injina, Satyabhamapur, Gotalgam, Allarpur, Padmakesharipur, Nishchintakoili, Shyamsundarpur, Kalarahanga, Raghunathpur and Pathargadia.

A Special Camp was organized in the adopted village of Pathargadia, under Chandaka Panchayat, Bhubaneswar, Odisha to facilitate deeper social connectivity between the society and the volunteers. The volunteers engaged themselves in various activities involving the locals of the campsite and provided a strong platform for community engagement. The Special

Camp organised included activities like Demographic Survey, Drugs Abuse Awareness Nukkad, Skit on Road Safety, Yoga, Plantation drive, Drawing, Dancing and Singing sessions, Swach Bharat Abhiyaan, Personal Health and Hygiene Awareness, Self Defence Session, Story Telling Session, Ganesh Puja Celebration, Origami Session, Good touch - Bad Touch Session, Road Safety Rally.

### 3.11 Activities by Students under National Service Scheme

Students and faculty members have been participating in National Service Scheme and National Cadet Corps activities through Social awareness campaigns, Street play on Social issues, Blood donation camps, Cycle rally and training the underprivileged children etc.

Two units of National Service Scheme (NSS), one for boys and one for girls with 500 students in each, are functioning in the University. This fosters national integration through community living and co-operative action. Presently NSS activities with strength of 500 volunteers are functional in the University with the approval of the Govt. of Odisha. The students are also involved in visiting villages and orphanages to spread awareness for education, deliver tailored educational programs and take initiatives to connect the deprived with the mainstream of the society.

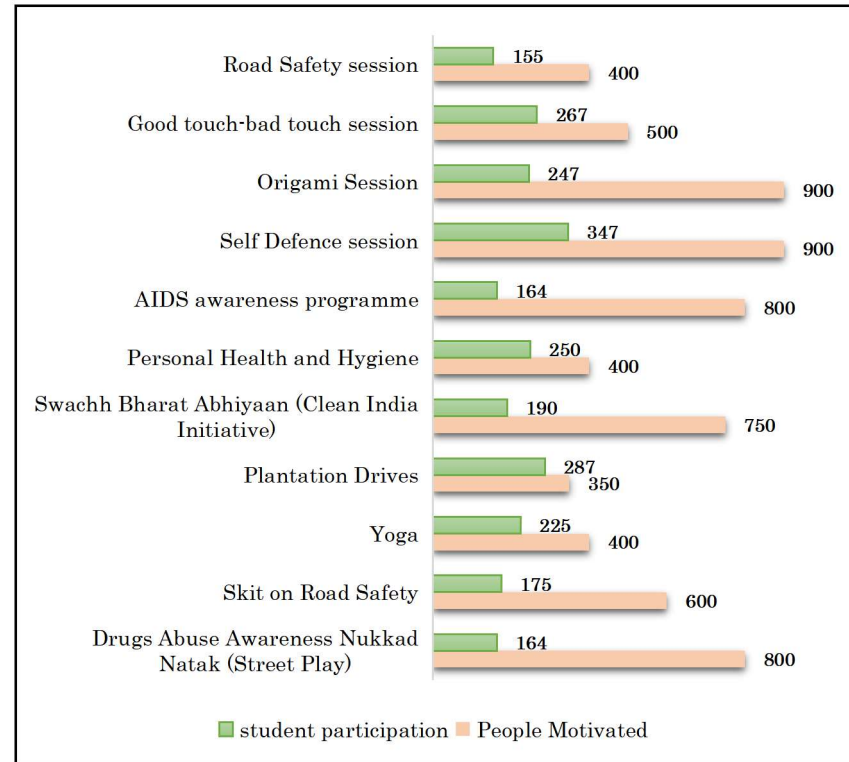

### 3.12 ENACTUS

ENACTUS KISS-KIIT' is an innovative initiative by the students of the University to improve the quality of life in society. Under the initiative, in 2016, Project SIDDHI was undertaken, which provided opportunity to the oppressed communities specially the transgenders in

and around Bhubaneswar to change their lives for the better. They also spread the awareness to eliminate the use of plastic bags by replacing it with handmade paper bags.

After successful collaboration with the transgender, ENACTUS worked with a voluntary organization, Aaina. The students also worked with the disabled women to make them self-sufficient. The disabled women worked on an order of 5000 newspaper bags from Urban Micro and started making crafty bags with designs like gift bags from handmade paper.

ENACTUS in collaboration with Daya Foundation, an organization working for women from backward areas prepared an order for “Delight Bakeries” of 14000 brown paper bags with customized print. Another order with the founder of “Biggies, Burger n more” for an order of 20000 brown paper bags with customized print in collaboration with Niyatee Foundation (<https://www.niyateefoundation.org/>) and Udyog Foundation (<http://udfoundation.org.in/>) was undertaken.

ENWIPE, a project introduced by KISS-KIIT, is a unique concept of water-less car wash service at customer’s doorstep. ENACTUS promoted a special eco-friendly solution for cleaning the vehicles, adding only 500ml of water to 5ml of the solution. The main aim of Project Enwipe is to use minimal amount of water and provide employment opportunities to under privileged and physically challenged (hearing and speech impaired) individuals, simultaneously helping them earn and live as equal contributors in society.



## 3.13 KanyaKiran 3.0

Third edition of Kanya Kiran' program in association with United Nations Women and Kalinga Fellowship was organised in May 2019. The program covered all the Panchayats of the State of Odisha in India, spreading awareness on social evils of violence against women and girl child among millions of households. Over 3000 staff, particularly women staff were actively involved as coordinators and volunteers. They disseminated the message at household level in villages amid overwhelming response. The Women folk also were made aware of hygiene and environmental issues.

### 3.20 Other Outreach and Awareness Programs

School of Biotechnology in collaboration with the School of Rural Management has developed a rural health research centre at Chikiti, Ganjam. It has brought several ICT platforms and diagnostic technologies for rural masses. Two Rural Dispensaries have been established and operational in Kalarabanka and Aska. More than 100 conferences/ seminars are organized in the University yearly.

- Basic life support
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation & first aid
- Fire safety and prevention

Awareness on the procedures to resuscitate the victim through First Aid service, especially when one collapses following stroke was done. The steps of Basic Life Support (BLS), which comprises of the steps like (i) Scene Safety ii) Check Response iii) Activate EMS (Emergency Medical Service) and (iv) Get an AED ( Automated External Defibrillator ) were discussed. People are made aware of the various methods of First Aid for different cases of choking, snake bite, insect bite, spinal injury, road accidents, fever etc.



In case of Training on Fire safety and prevention, the emphasis is given on the methods of operating a Fire Extinguisher especially following the P.A.S.S. (Pull, Aim, Squeeze and Sweep) method and following the R.A.C.E.(Rescue, Alert, Confine and Evacuation) method, in case of emergency.

World Environment Day has been observed at KIIT & KISS on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 amid enthusiasm. On this occasion, the students and employees of KIIT and KISS have planted hundreds of saplings in order to make the campuses pollution free, sustain healthy ambiance and give a face-lift to the premises. In fact, every year lakhs of tree saplings are planted here at KIIT and KISS under the guidance Dr. Achyuta Samanta, Founder, KIIT & KISS. It is a matter of great concern that, the devastating cyclone 'Fani' has taken its toll on the lush green environs of KIIT and KISS recently. It has even uprooted bigger trees those were planted 10 years ago. Under the direction of The Founder, a massive plantation drive has been undertaken in the campuses of KIIT Group of Institutions and KISS this year. Lakhs

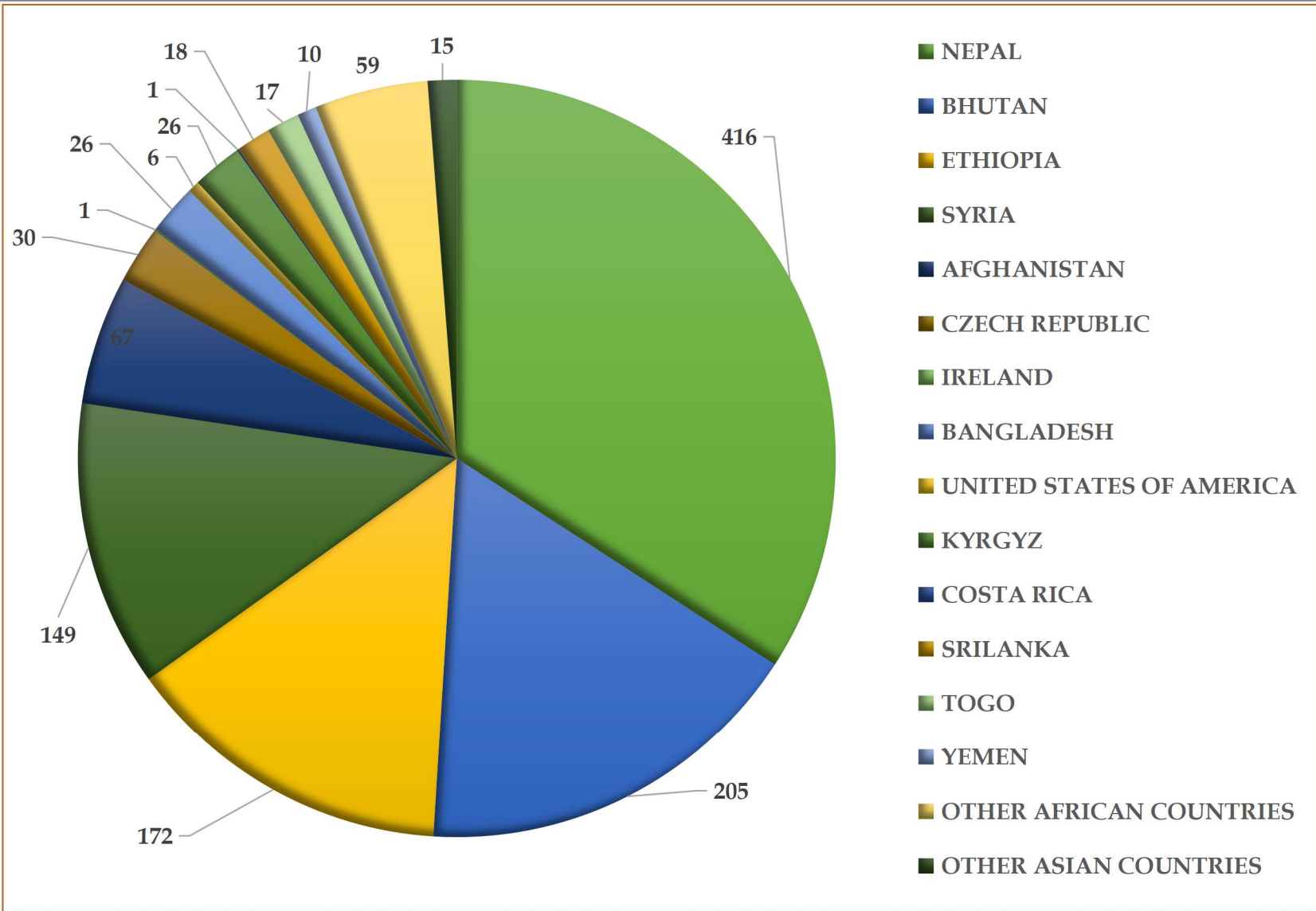
