RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

Research and innovation are important hallmarks of a world-class university. KIIT has established 19 Centers of Excellence with industry to promote collaborative research. KIIT Faculty are actively involved in research and consultancy works attracting financial support to the tune of a few million dollars every year. Currently nearly 100 research and consultancy projects funded by various national and international funding agencies like UBS Promedica Foundation, Switzerland; Karolinska Institute, Sweden; DST, DBT, MNRE, Govt. of India, Board of Research in Nuclear Sciences, etc. are ongoing with substantial budget outlay.

Faculty members and research scholars of the University actively publish research papers in various national and international journals of repute. Over 14,700 research papers have been indexed in international databases like Scopus and Web of Science. The research papers have received a high citation, pushing up the 'h' index to 83. The University has 331 filed patents; 87 patents have been published and 198 have been granted so far.

To promote innovation and startup entrepreneurship among students as well as in wider society, KIIT opened KIIT Technology Business Incubator (KIIT-TBI) in 2008. One of its kind initiative in Odisha and among only 60- odd in the country, KIIT-TBI is supported by the Department of Science & Technology (DST), National Science & Technology Entrepreneurship Development Board (NSTEDB), and scores of other agencies. It was recognised as a Centre of Excellence in 2018. KIIT-TBI is presently supporting 235+ budding technology driven entrepreneurs, including 60+ women start-ups. As many as 65 start-ups have received national and international awards, while more than 50 have received follow on funding.

TUTOR- MENTOR SYSTEM





Faculty advisors or Tutor Mentors help, advise and guide the students with respect to academics and related issues. It helps the students to solve their academic and personal problems and respond to all correspondence concerning them. The major task undertaken by the tutor-mentor is to make sure that the new entrants feel comfortable in the new ambience. While the faculty advisors/tutor mentors monitor the student activities and identify the students who need a special counselling, counsellors provide those students who all are academically deficient or emotionally distressed for academic or non-academic reasons. Services of professional psychiatrists are also available as required.

Student Counselling and Grievance redressal forum

The Counselling Section provides professional counselling and psychological boosting which include evaluation and therapy for a wide variety of personal situations. These range from adjusting to new environment, significant depression, anxiety, anger trauma, Interpersonal problems and other difficulties. Counselling service is rendered by a staff counsellor and a professional psychiatrist.

All the academic activities of the international students are planned by the Dean Academics - International Students. The primary responsibility of the Dean Academics is to collaborate with the heads of different Schools and address all academic grievances of the foreign students. The Dean Academics actively supports the International Relations Office (IRO) with academic inputs. The selection and counselling of the students going abroad for exchange programme/ semester abroad programme are also facilitated by the Dean. He/She is assisted by the Academic Coordinator (Foreign Students) along with the Faculty-in-charge (International Students) from every School and follow the objective of keeping a close connect with all foreign students studying in KIIT to indirectly facilitate and promote the Institute's strategic international agenda.















SPORTS & FACILITIES

At KIIT and KISS, Educational Excellence and sporting brilliance go hand in hand. Holistic development is the cornerstone of KIIT and KISS. Besides academics, effort is made to scout talent among the students, provide all necessary support and bring out the best in each one of them.

KIIT and KISS are proud to have rich sporting culture. They have created world class sports infrastructure and engaged international coaches in several disciplines to hone talents. Students have been bringing glory for the state and country for the last 15 years.


KIIT and KISS, in it's journey, are determined to build upon this beginning and hope to bring more glory for the country and the state in the years to come.

Facilities

KIIT is well-known for its world-class infrastructure. Not only does each stream of education have a self-contained independent campus, but KIIT also has placed ultra-modern facilities, like Wi-Fi multimedia, air conditioned classrooms, virtual classrooms, video conferencing, state-of-the-art laboratories, close circuit cameras, gym & health club, seminar halls, auditoriums and open air theatres, etc., for students' all round growth.

Conferences & Seminars:

KIIT provides excellent ambience for national and international level conferences and seminars. Its Central Convention Centre Complex houses a world-class Auditorium having a seating capacity of 1600, besides a Guest House with 5-star facilities (42 suites), Conference Halls (18), Exhibition Ground (5 acre) and Banquet Hall. It is the largest of its type in the state of Odisha and one of the best in Eastern India. In addition, there are well-equipped auditoriums and conference halls in each campus. There are 20 Open Air Theatres (OATs) in different campuses with capacities ranging from 500 to 50,000.

ADMISSIONS & SCHOLARSHIPS

International students enrolled in KIIT University can be categorized in one of these categories:

Self-Financed Students – Students or Legal Guardian pay the fees for the student. **Govt. Sponsored Students** – Students are sponsored either by Indian government scholarships or Scholarships given by their home country.

Sponsored Students – Students are sponsored by private entities or non-profit organizations. The scholarship providing bodies seek admission for the candidates as per their applications.

Dr. Homi J. Bhabha Scholarship Scheme (HJBSS) –

HJBSS is a scholarship scheme by Embassy of India in Nepal that provides admission with 100% scholarships to top Indian Universities for pursuing Masters in Engineering.

Silver Jubilee Scholarship Scheme (SJSS)

Study in India Scholarship(SII)

Study in India, with the help of the following Indian ministries - the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, is offering 2000 scholarships up-to USD 3500 each.

Every meritorious student that has been offered this scholarship by the Study in India team shall receive it for a maximum period:

of 5 years for undergraduate integrated courses; of 3 or 4 years for undergraduate courses, according to the course duration;

of 2 years for postgraduate courses;

Or, till the completion of the course, whichever is lesser. The scholarship covers tuition fees, hostel and food charges. Each student under this scholarship must attain a minimum of 70% attendance and 60% or above average CGPA each year for its validity.

The scholarship does not cover travel tickets, visa charges, personal expenses and medical insurance.
